The volunteer teacher aide shall be responsible for assisting the day care teacher(s) with a small group of 4-5 children ages 6 weeks to starting kindergarten. Also, the teacher aide may assist with the smooth operation of Sunshine Tykes.

- Apply strict hygiene criteria to the handling of children
- Lift/carry Children and equipment
- Play/sit on the floor with children
- Possibly care for children who are ill and/or contagious

- Be at least 15 Years of age
- Be able to obtain enrollment in the Central Background Registry

- Food Handler's Card
- Valid First Aid/CPR certification
- A minimum of 2-10 hours of weekly availability for a service term of 3 months
- A strong desire to work effectively with diverse backgrounds
- Ability to multi-task
